WHAT COOKIES DO WE USE AND FOR WHAT?

Below is a more detailed explanation of each type of cookie, temporality, ownership, purpose and domains:

Google Analytics is a web analysis service provided by Google, Inc., a Delaware company whose main office is at 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway, Mountain View (California), CA 94043, United States ("Google"):

Google Analytics uses the following cookies:

• _ga, _gat, _gid, y other possible cookies to be loaded by Google's visit monitoring service.

They:

- Generate a unique user ID, which is used to count how many times a user visits the site, as well as the date of the first and last visit to the site.
- Register the date and time of the access to any of the page of this Website
- Check the need to keep a user's session open or create a new one
- Identify the user's session to register the approximate geographic location of the computer accessing the Site for statistical purposes

Hubspot is a CRM service given by Hubspot, a Cambridge company whose headquarters are located at 25 First Street, 2nd Floor, Cambridge, MA 02141 United States The cookies used are:

- __hs_do_not_track. This cookie can be set to prevent the tracking code from sending information to HubSpot. Setting this cookie is different from unsubscribing from cookies in that it still allows anonymous information to be sent to HubSpot. Duration: 13 months
- hs-messages-is-open. This cookie is used to determine and save whether the chat widget is open for future visits. It is reset by closing the widget again after 30 minutes of inactivity. It expires after 30 minutes.

In addition, the following cookies are used:

- _fbp: Used by Facebook to provide a number of advertising products as realtime bids from third-party advertisers. Type: HTTP. Duration: 3 months.
- __cfduid: The '__cfduid' cookie is set by the CloudFlare service to identify trusted web traffic. It does not correspond to any user ID in the web application, nor does it store any personally identifiable data. Type: Own and persistent. Duration: 5 years.
- _stripe_mid: Session cookie for stripe: https://stripe.com/cookies-policy/legal Purpose: Used by the Stripe payment gateway, it stores a session ID needed to make the payment. Duration: Session Cookie, expires at the end of the session.
